Erasmus Written Exam

- Erasmus Written Exam will be held on Friday, April 14, 2023 at 13:00 via UZEM.
- The duration of the test is 60 minutes. (50 questions)
- The candidate students will log in Uzem (uzem.arel.edu.tr) to access the exam on the date and time indicated above.
- The name of the exam on UZEM is '2022-23 ACADEMIC YEAR ERASMUS ENGLISH PROFICIENCY EXAM'

Speaking Exam:

- Only the 80 students with the highest scores of the writing exam will be taken to the "SPEAKING" Exam. 60 students with the highest Speaking score will be selected.
- ➤ Speaking Exam will be held on Friday on April 28, 2023 between 09.00 13.30 and via Microsoft Teams.
- > The list of the students selected for the Speaking Exam will be announced on 20th April. In the list, students can see the approximate time when each student will be taken to the Speaking Exam on 28th April so that they can prepare themselves.
- > Students can join the Speaking Exam on their phones on condition that the requirements of the exam are provided.

Requirements of the Speaking Exam:

- Students 'cameras and microphones must remain ON during the exam. (No excuses regarding the microphones or cams will be accepted. Typing in the chatbox will NOT be accepted.) Students who turn off their microphone or camera during the exam will be dismissed from the exam. In other words, students who do not provide the requirements of the Speaking Exam will NOT be allowed.
- Students must be in a secluded (quiet) environment where there won't be any form of distraction (noise/sound) during the exam.
- It is important that these students' email addresses with the istanbularel.edu.tr extension be active so that they can log in the Teams for the Speaking Exam. (They must know their passwords and usernames.) Otherwise, they cannot log in the Teams.
